AREQUIPA (COLCA): FD SIBAYO **L**

Departure to see South American camelid (alpaca, llama, etc.) raising and lifestyle of a rancher in a stay (3:30hrs). In addition, two of these activities can be realized:

- Visit to Family Farm (2h)
- Visit to the ecological garden of the village (1.30 h)
- Fishing in the Colca River (1.30 h)
- Walking the village (1.30 h)
- Fabrics with a local family (1h)

CUSCO: LAMAS VILLAGE EXPERIENCE

Transfer to Cusco to **Lamay**, a traditional and not touristic village in the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Upon arrival, we will have a brief interpretation of the activities of the village and the agricultural labor in the fields. Then, we will walk in the village and visit some traditional houses and local businesses, such as the sheds for guinea pig breeding, the traditional "Chicherias" of corn beer, the "Pichinku" natural dyes project and other local activities Lamay has to offer. Finally, transfer to Cusco.

CUSCO: FOOD & AGRICULTURE

Transfer from Cusco to **Lamay** to learn about Cusco and the Sacred Valley gastronomy. Upon arrival, transfer to the **community of Huayllafara** where the locals will take us to visit their farms with traditional crops (like potatoes, oca, anu, tarwi, quinuas, beans, among others) and will teach us about their traditional farming techniques, while we taste their local produce. Then, we will visit a garden with veggies, lately incorporated to the local gastronomic offer. We will learn about the local culture and their daily activities, according to the time of year and the agricultural calendar. The tour and interpretation will be focused in the agricultural and food processing techniques, such as the preparation of chuño and moraya, the washing and uses of quinoa, elaboration of Chicha de Jora and other interesting Andean activities. Finally, we will return to Lamay for the cooking lessons. The idea is to prepare Peruvian classic recipes and use the native products in the cooking process. To encourage the spirit, we will prepare pisco sour or enjoy a Pisco tasting session. Finally, transfer to Cusco.

CUSCO: LAMAY COMMUNITY DAY

Transfer from Cusco to **Lamay** to visit one of the mountain communities of our project "La Base Lamay", learn about their life, traditions and contribute with the sustainable development of the community. We will meet at La Base and coordinate the activity with the group. The community will welcome us and teach us their traditions and traditions. We will participate in a spontaneous "farm work" and recognize the different varieties of local crops and plants, learning also about their farming traditional tools and techniques. After the activity, we will have a typical lunch, based on the food produced by the community. In the afternoon, the women will share with us the art and process of weaving, very important in their family dynamics, and we will have the opportunity to talk with them about their customs and their role in the field. Finally, transfer to Cusco.

CUSCO: HUAYLLAFARA & LAMAY

Transfer from Cusco to Lamay to take a hike towards the **community of Huayllafara**. We will walk uphill along a single track that follows the Carmen River until we take a turn up through a forested and biodiverse creek, native trees and plenty of birds that will take us to the community of Huayllafara. From the community, we will have great views of the local farms and the typical houses. We will see women and men doing their traditional agricultural work, livestock, traditional crafts and family life. We will back to Lamay to have lunch. In the afternoon, visit the **community of Lamay**, a traditional and not touristic village in the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Upon arrival, we will have a brief interpretation of the activities of the village and the agricultural labor in the fields. Then, we will walk in the village and visit some traditional houses and local businesses, such as the sheds for guinea pig breeding, the traditional "Chicherias" of corn beer, the "Pichinku" natural dyes project and other local activities Lamay has to offer. PUNO: CCOTOS AND AMANTANI

1st day | Puno / Ccotos **L D**

Transfer to the port and embarkation to the **Ccotos community** (3.15h). Arrival and stay in the lodging houses of the community. After lunch with the villagers, they make a presentation of their culture showing how they currently live. Then you will visit the village and its artisanal center, to then ascend to Ancasayana, *Apu* (Dios) guardian of Ccotos, mystical and millenary place with archeological pre-Incan rests. Then, you will go on sailing boats to visit the **Ticonata Island** (30m) to visit the site museum. Return to Ccotos to tend fishing nets and observe the sunset on the reed beds and the immensity of the lake. At night, dinner with the villagers. Overnight.

2nd day | Ccotos / Amantani Island **B L D**

At dawn (5.30am), you will pick up the fishing nets and breakfast observing the rising of the sun. Then, you will make farming activities (according to season). Before midday, you will board to **Amantani Island**. Arrival and accommodation in the lodging houses of the villagers. After lunch, climb to Pacha Tata, mystical ceremonial center of the island, where you will also experience the sunset in the lake. At night, dinner with the villagers. Overnight.

3rd day | Amantani Island / Taquile Island / Uros / Puno **B L**

After breakfast, embarkation to the **Taquile Island** (1.30h) to know its craftworks and the interest places. The lunch will be accompanied with music and typical dances of Taquile. You will then board to the **Uros floating islands** to see a presentation of their culture and travel in totora rafts. New embarkation to the Puno port and transfer to the hotel.
