COLCA: COLCA CANYONS

PRIVATE 2D/1N

1st day | Arequipa / Colca **L**

At 8am, departure to Colca going past the towns of **Yura**, **Pampa de Arrieros** and **Pampa Cañahuas**, where the national Reserve of vicuñas is located. Continue the trip to **Chuccura** and **Patapampa**, where the **Mirador de los Volcanes** is located. Arrive to Chivay to have lunch. In the afternoon, **visit the market of the town** and the hot springs of La Calera (entrance is not included).

2nd day | Colca / Arequipa

At 6.15am, transfer to the **Cruz Del Condor** vantage point. Then, visit the towns of **Macca** and **Yanque**, and the **Antahuilque** and **Choquetico** viewpoints. At 1pm., return to Arequipa.

SIC 2D/1N

Similar to the program "Private 2d/1n", with the following differences:

- The lunch on the first day is not included.
- Clients will not visit La Calera if they are lodged at the Colca Lodge.

PRIVATE 2D/1N + TRANSFER TO PUNO

1st day | 01 Arequipa / Colca **L**

At 8am, departure to Colca going past the towns of **Yura**, **Pampa de Arrieros** and **Pampa Cañahuas**, where the national Reserve of vicuñas is located. Continue the trip to **Chuccura** and **Patapampa**, where the **Mirador de los Volcanes** is located. Arrive to Chivay to have lunch. In the afternoon, **visit the market of the town** and the hot springs of La Calera (entrance is not included).

2nd day | Colca / Puno

At 6.15am, transfer to the **Cruz Del Condor** vantage point. Then, visit the towns of **Macca** and **Yanque**, and the **Antahuilque** and **Choquetico** viewpoints. At midday, departure to Puno (Km. 320, 6-hour journey), going past different towns and the beautiful lagoon of Lagunillas.

If there is an extension to **Sillustani**, the 1st day the transfer will be Arequipa/Cruz del Condor directly. For the 2nd day, transfer will be Colca/Puno directly.

SIC 2D/1N + TRANSFER TO PUNO

Similar to the program "Private 2d/1n + Transfer to Puno", with the following differences:

- The lunch on the first day is not included.
- Clients will not visit La Calera if they are lodged at the Colca Lodge or Refugio.
- The bus to Puno departs at midday approximately.

PRIVATE 3D/2N

1st day | Arequipa / Colca **L**

At 8am, departure to Colca going past the towns of **Yura**, **Pampa de Arrieros** and **Pampa Cañahuas**, where the national Reserve of vicuñas is located. Continue the trip to **Chuccura** and **Patapampa**, where the **Mirador de los Volcanes** is located. Arrive to Chivay to have lunch. In the afternoon, **visit the market of the town** and the hot springs of La Calera (entrance is not included).

2nd day | Colca

At 6.15am, transfer to the **Cruz Del Condor** vantage point. Then, visit the towns of **Macca** and **Yanque**, and the **Antahuilque** and **Choquetico** viewpoints. In the afternoon, it is possible to do short hikes to **Uyu Uyu** and **Puente Sifón**.

3rd day | Colca / Arequipa

Visit to the towns on the right margin of the Valley, like Coporaque. At 1.30pm, return to Arequipa.

SIC 3D/2N

1st day | Arequipa / Colca

At 8am, departure to Colca going past the towns of **Yura**, **Pampa de Arrieros** and **Pampa Cañahuas**, where the national Reserve of vicuñas is located. Continue the trip to **Chuccura** and **Patapampa**, where the **Mirador de los Volcanes** is located. Arrive to Chivay to have lunch. In the afternoon, **visit the market of the town** and the hot springs of La Calera (entrance is not included).

2nd day | Colca

Day is at leisure.

3rd day | Colca / Arequipa

PRIVATE 3D/2N + TRANSFER TO PUNO

1st day | Arequipa / Colca **L**

2nd day | Colca

At 6.15am, transfer to the **Cruz Del Condor** vantage point. Then, visit the towns of **Macca** and **Yanque**, and the **Antahuilque** and **Choquetico** viewpoints. In the afternoon, it is possible to do short hikes to **Uyu Uyu** and **Puente Sifón**.

3rd day | Colca / Puno

Visit to the towns on the right margin of the Valley, like **Coporaque**. At midday, departure to Puno (Km. 320, 6-hour journey), going past different towns and the beautiful lagoon of Lagunillas.

If there is an extension to **Sillustani**, the excursion on the 3rd day will be made on the 2nd day, and on the 3rd day pax will depart to Puno directly.

SIC 3D/2N + TRANSFER TO PUNO

CUSCO: THE BEE SANCTUARY

Early departure from Cusco to the **Sanctuary of Bees** located in Calca. We will meet there with Alicia or Fede that are the responsible of this important project of conservation of bees and their habitat and the importance of a sustainable beekeeping management. The goal of this project is to raise awareness of the importance of the work of bees in the wild and agricultural biodiversity conservation. When visiting the bee sanctuary, we will learn about the social organization of hives, their communication and the relationship with plants and flowers and what bees represent in different cultures around the world. The hives provide us with products that are the foundation of powerful medicines and natural cosmetics. It is a good opportunity to understand the biological connection and spiritual with the Pachamama and contribute to the conservation of biodiversity and important ancient and eternal wisdom. At the end of the activity, back to Cusco.

CUSCO: SKY'S GUARDIANS

8am Departure to the province of Anta. After 1-hour journey, we will visit **Quillarumiyoc** (3.650 masl, dedicated to the Moon and Water). Then, we will proceed to the village of **Limatambo** (2.555 masl), to visit **Tarawasi** (ceremonial center). Afterwards, we will continue, through a rural path, until the community of Chonta (3.465 masl). From here, we will hike for 1 hour to reach the **condor's belvedere**, on the Apurimac River. After having appreciated the magical performance of these sky's guardians, we will hike to Chonta where the transportation will transfer us to Cusco, arriving at 5-6pm.

LIMA: PALOMINO ISLAND

The meeting point is El Callao Marina Club to embark a motorboat toward the Callao's island. At first, we observed the anchorage of yachts, sailing boats and merchant ships in Callao bay. On the way, we will go by a sand bank called "El Camotal" and the San Lorenzo and El Frontón islands. At Cabinzas Island, we could appreciate several colonies of Humbolt penguins. We will arrive to the farthest point: **Palomino Island**. Here, we can admire and swim with a large colony of sea lions (sea wolves). Finally, we will back to Marina Club arriving at 1pm.

PARACAS: BALLESTAS ISLAND

The **Ballestas Islands** are located 30 minutes sailing from the dock and are part of the Paracas National Park. Once out of the bay sail in front of the Punta Pejerrey port and then before heading to the islands one can admire the **Candelabro** curious figured made in the slopes of a sandy hill that looks like a tree or candelabra. These islands shelter abundant fauna like South American sea lion (*Otaria Byronia*), South American fur seal (*Arctocephalus Australis*), marine otter (*Lontra Felina*), and Humboldt penguin (*Spheniscus Humboldti*). In the site also live thousands of native and migratory birds such as the Peruvian pelican (*Pelecanus Thagus*), the black skimmer (*Rynchops Niger Cinerascens*), the Peruvian booby (*Sula Variegata*), and the guanay cormorant (*Phalacrocorax Bougainvillii*), among others.

PIURA: HUMPBACK WHALES WATCHING

Through the months of July up to the month of October, whale watching is available to observe the humpback whales that arrive from the Antarctic waters to the North Shore of Peru to mate and raise their calves. During the tour, you will be able to see these magnificent cetaceans making extraordinary leaps. There is also the possibility of seeing the common dolphin, sea lions, turtles, blue-footed boobies, etc.
